

1. Transcript

3. Academic Year

The Academic Year consists of two semesters. The courses and the grades along with credits are shown against each semester in which the student is registered.

4. Evaluation

A. The evaluation of the student is continuous and carried out through evaluation instruments namely tests, quizzes, projects, home assignments, case participation and written examinations.

B. The performance in most courses is spelt out in terms of letter grades: A, B, C, D, E. Each letter grade has a qualitative meaning and a grade point value as given below:

C. In some courses, descriptive non-letter grades (Excellent; Good; Satisfactory(S); Unsatisfactory(U)) are awarded which do not carry any grade points.

5. CGPA

Cumulative Grade Point Average is a cumulative performance indicator at the end of semester. The CGPA which is a weighted average is calculated as shown below:

$$\text{GPA / CGPA} = (c_1g_1 + c_2g_2 + c_3g_3 + \dots) / (c_1 + c_2 + c_3 + \dots)$$

c₁, c₂, c₃, ... Denote Credits associated with the courses taken by the student and g₁, g₂, g₃, ... denote grade points of the letter grades awarded in the respective courses, provided that when a student repeats a course, the new grade replaces the earlier one in the calculation of the CGPA.
