## Grading and Evaluation System

The evaluation of each course consists of Continuous Assessment (CA) and Semester End Assessment (SEA) in the ratio 2:3 for all taught courses. CA and SEA grade and grade points are calculated using indirect grading system based on a 7 point scale as shown below. Decimals are to be rounded to the next higher whole number.

Percentage of marks	Grade	Grade point
90 – 100	A+ - Outstanding	10
80 – 89	A - Excellent	9
70 – 79	B - Very Good	8
60 – 69	C - Good	7
50 – 59	D - Satisfactory	6
40 – 49	E - Adequate	5
00 – 39	F - Failure	4

A separate minimum of 30% marks each for CA and SEA (for both theory and practical) and an aggregate minimum of 40% are required for a pass in a course.

Credit Point (CP) of a course is calculated using the formula:-

$CP = Cr \times GP$ , where Cr = Credit; GP = Grade point

Semester Credit Point Average (SCPA) of a Semester is calculated using the formula:-

$SCPA = TCP/TCr$ , where TCP = Total Credit Point of that semester, TCr = Total Credit of that semester

Cumulative Credit Point Average (CCPA) of a Programme is calculated using the formula:-

$CCPA = TCP/TCr$ , where TCP = Total Credit Point of the semesters, TCr = Total Credit of the programme.

CPA	Grade
Above 9	A+ - Outstanding
Above 8 but $\leq 9$	A - Excellent
Above 7 but $\leq 8$	B - Very Good
Above 6 but $\leq 7$	C - Good
Above 5 but $\leq 6$	D - Satisfactory
Above 4 but $\leq 5$	E - Adequate
$\leq 4$	F - Failure

For a pass in a programme, a separate minimum of E grade is required for all courses and an overall E grade is mandatory. If a candidate secures F Grade for any one of the courses offered in a semester or programme, only F grade will be awarded to that semester/ programme until the candidate improves this to E grade or above within the permitted period.
